Free from fertiliser, thistles, docks, nettles, rushes, ragwort

Soils

Testing - need very low nutrients, soil pH to determine plants are suited to the area.

1.8kg yellow Rattle

0.2ha

Yr1 = 14.6 ha seeded 166 kg wildflower seed

Still contains several Red-listed plants and 3 Nationally Scarce spiders of wetlands and damp grasslands

Invasive plants: Hemlock Water-dropwort Soft Rush Grey Willow
