

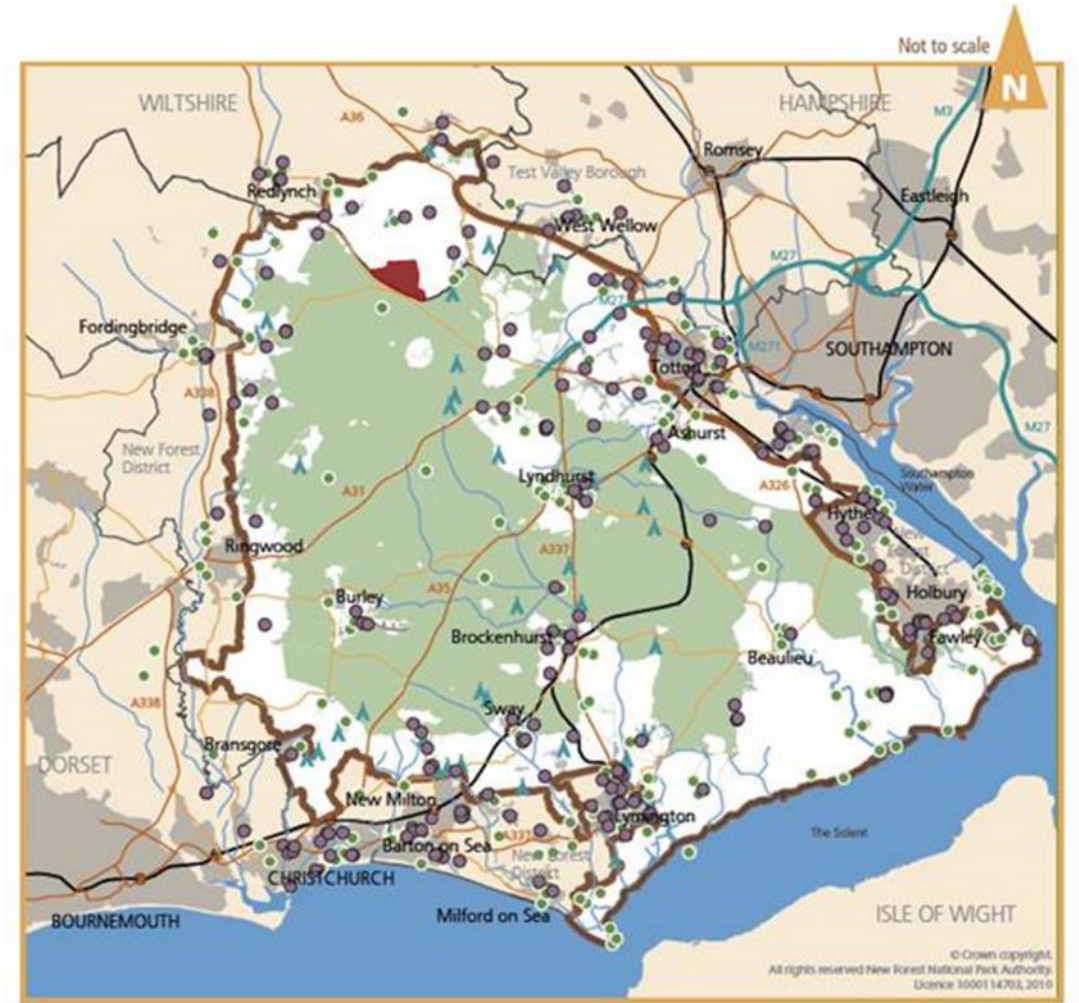
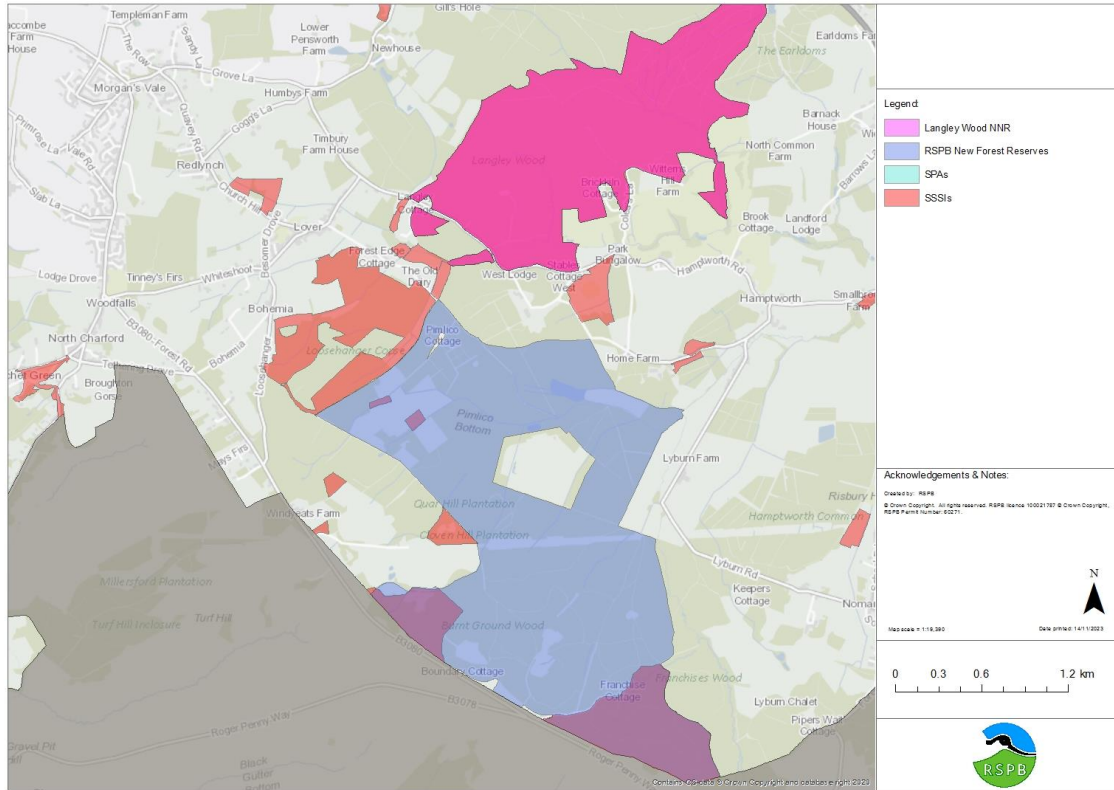

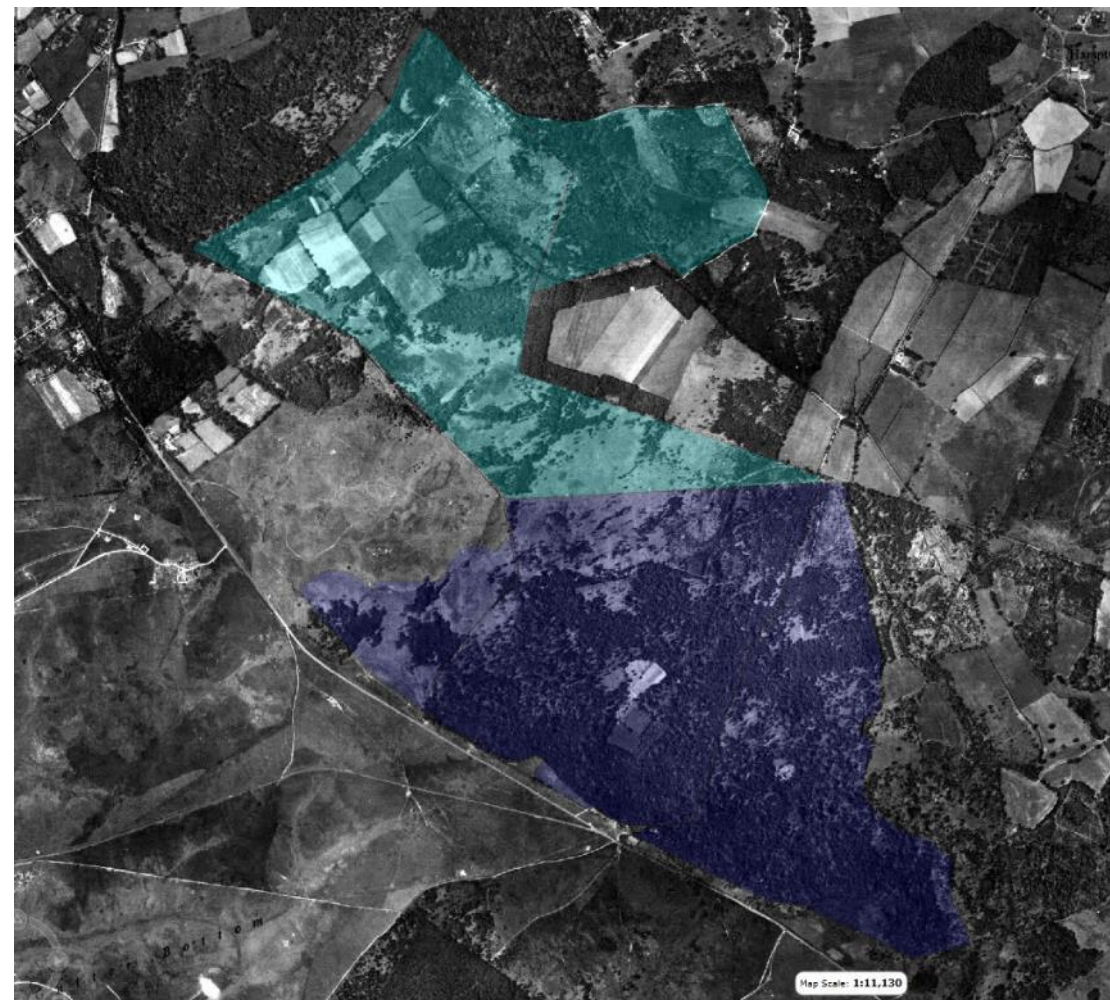

Location



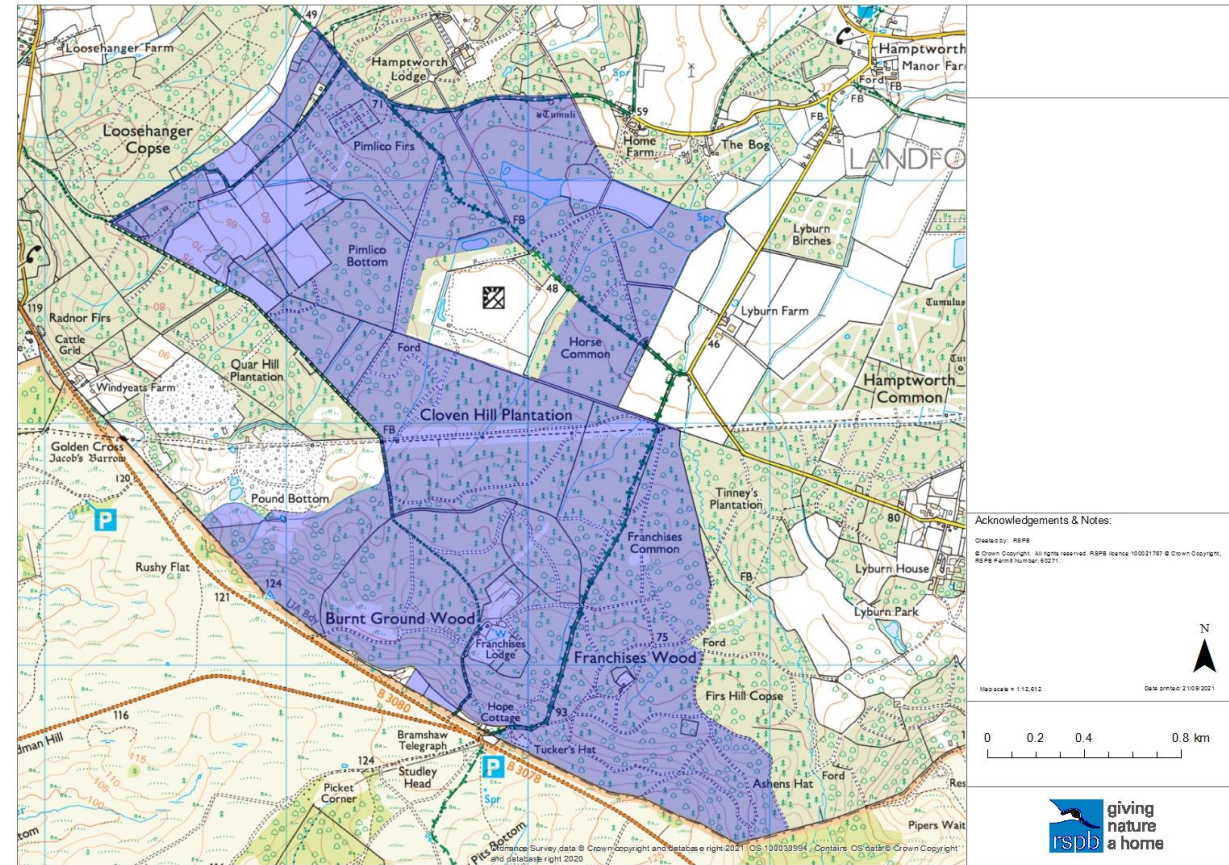

- Monitor changes.



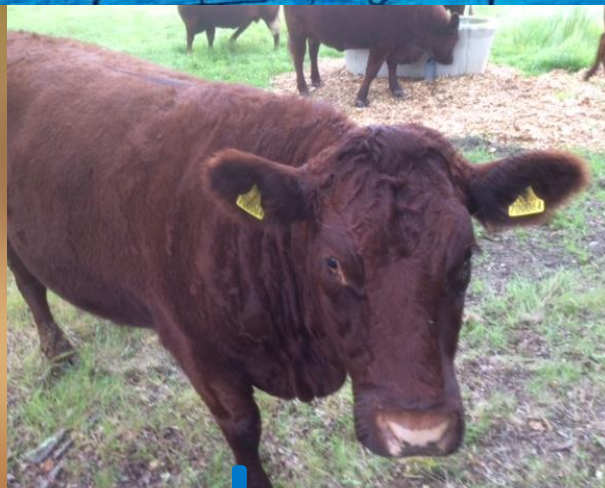
